



PROGRAM AND IMPACT

Perseverance on Vine consists of four buildings with 32 affordable housing units. The project has rehabilitated 3 of 8 historic buildings and has infilled 1 of 2 vacant lots within the 15th Steet block of Vine Street in Cincinnati's Over-the-Rhine neighborhood. The units will provide housing to those whose income falls within 30-60% of the Area Median Income (AMI). According to data from 2010-2014 from the U.S. Census Bureau, 32 out of 100 families in urban Hamilton County whose income fall below 60% AMI, do not have access to affordable housing. Perseverance on Vine not only brings life back into this segment of the neighborhood, but also helps fill the affordable housing gap within the city.
